His Life's Journey

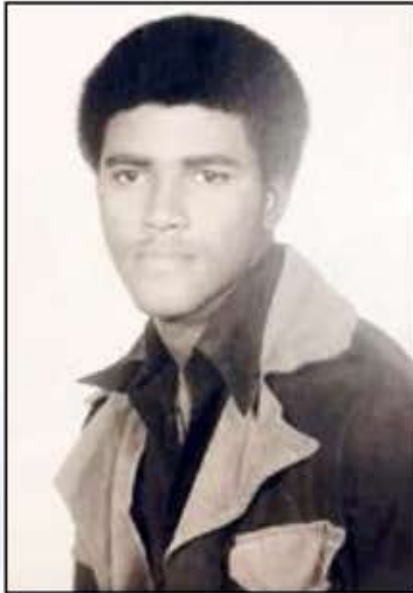
