His Life's Story

The journey of a wonderful life began January 23, 1952. On this day, **Clifton Terry Richard** was born in Alexandria, Louisiana to Mazie Terry and was the only child.

The family moved to Mamou, Louisiana where he attended and graduated from Mamou High School. He joined the United States Army and did several tours of duty.

Terry received training as an Electrical Technician. He was employed at Boeing, Northrop Grumman, and NASA. After retirement, he was employed parttime as a school bus driver with First Student Bus Company for the last nine years. During his employment he made a significant imprint on the lives of the students he served, making sure they followed the rules, and loving them enough to give them snacks as they exited the bus in the afternoons.
