Dettra Lynn Revis was born May 06, 1959 to Bouldin B. & Rosalind M. Revis. Dettra parents had strong faith & practice in the Catholic Religion, making it a priority to provide their children with an education in the local Catholic Schools. Receiving the best academic education while learning how to have a relationship with God, Dettra grew up in the city of Inglewood, California. Educated in the Catholic Archdiocese. She completed St. Eugene's Elementary, and then graduated from St. Michaels Catholic High School. After graduating, Dettra entered the workforce where she started a career working for the Los Angeles Urban League.

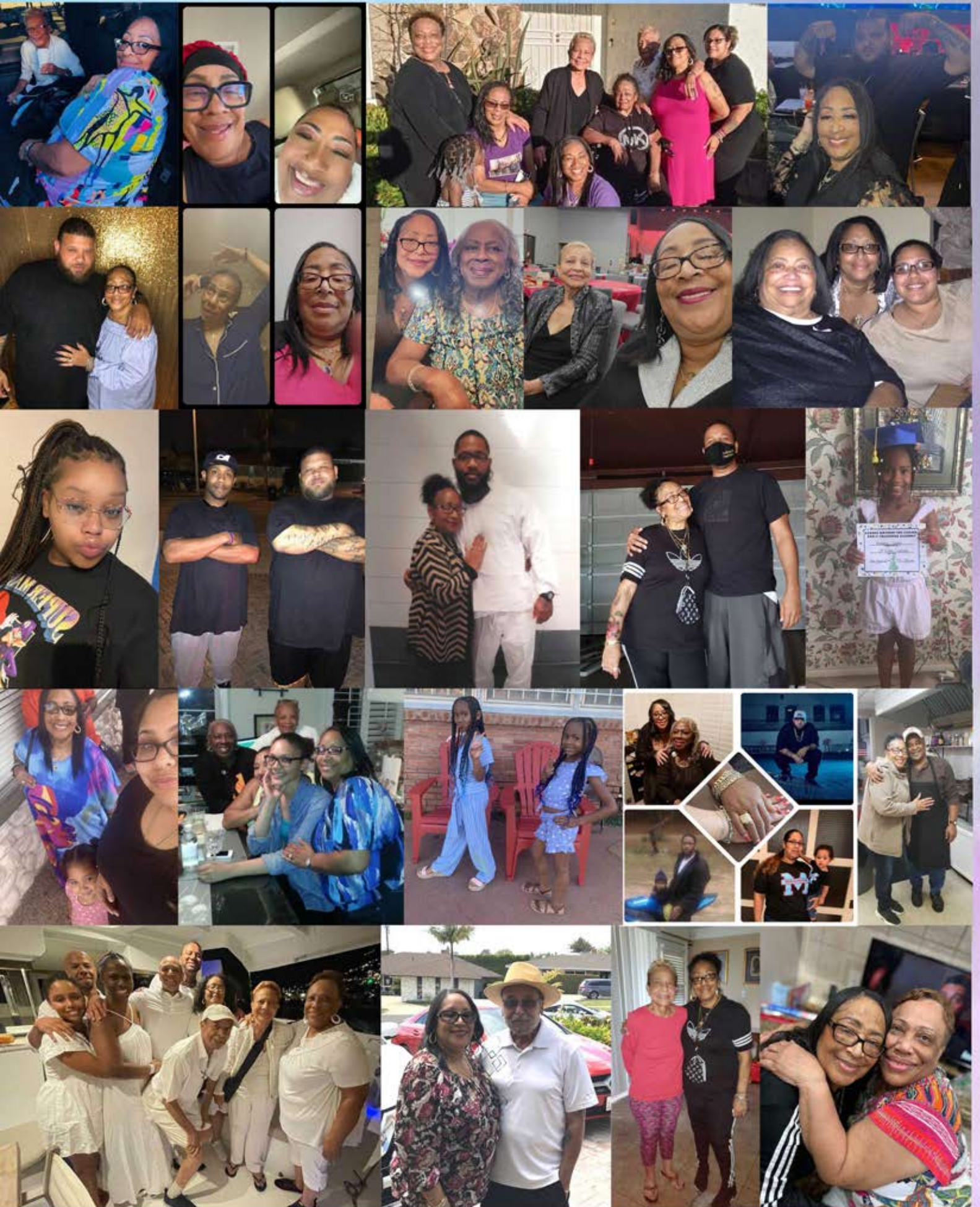
